for Mac: **Users/(user name)/Library/Application Support/Adobe/Adobe PDF/Settings**

Before converting files to PDF

- Verify all fonts are embedded.
- Ensure that links to images are current and high-res.
- Make sure bleeds are at least .125" beyond trim in your native document.
- Convert all Spot Colors to CMYK. This can be done in the color palette of your native document or in the “Output” section of the PDF Export by selecting the “Ink Manager” button. (See Figure D)

Precautions

- Be aware that if you begin with low-resolution artwork, you cannot upsample it and maintain image quality. Starting your project with high-resolution artwork will yield the best results. Using the correct PDF Export Presets, you can downsample (see Compression presets) without compromising image quality.
- Transparencies include: opacity levels, blending modes, drop shadows, feathering, live effects, styles, and brushes. Adobe® recommends keeping your transparencies *live* (and not flattened) as long as possible. This will enable us (your print service provider) to reproduce the highest quality transparency. The best way to guarantee live transparency is to use **PDF/X-4**, an ISO standard.

File Formats that do not support transparency and must be flattened include: Adobe PDF 1.3, PDF/X-1a or X-3, PostScript, EPS, DCS, GIF, JPEG, BMP, and TIFF images created prior to Photoshop 6.0. Also, all PDF files created by Acrobat Distiller.

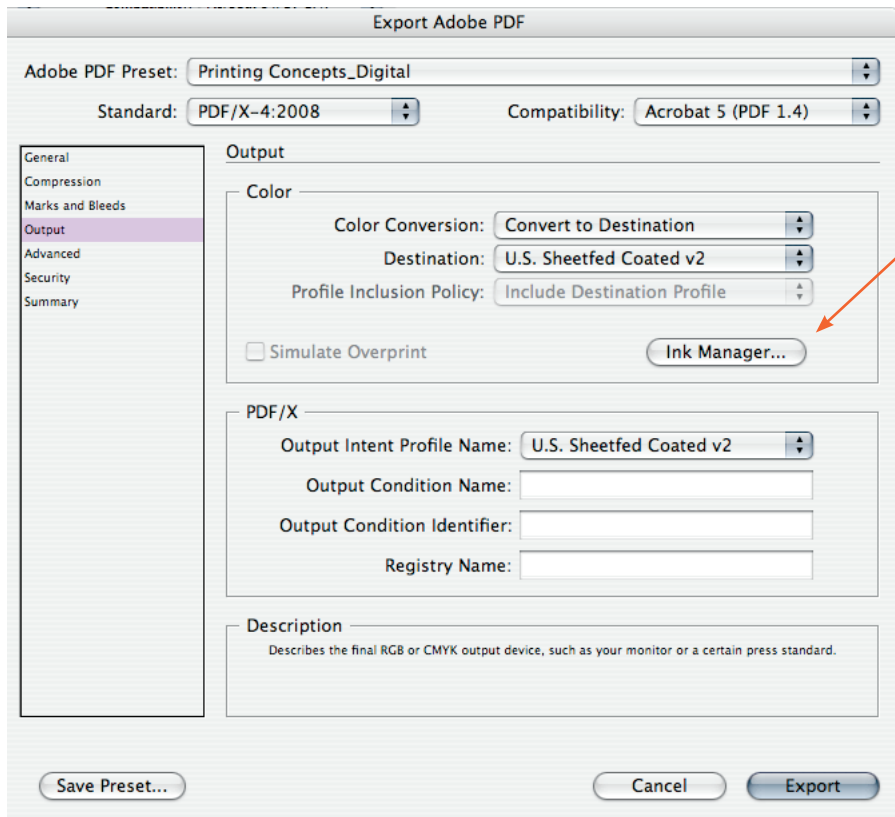

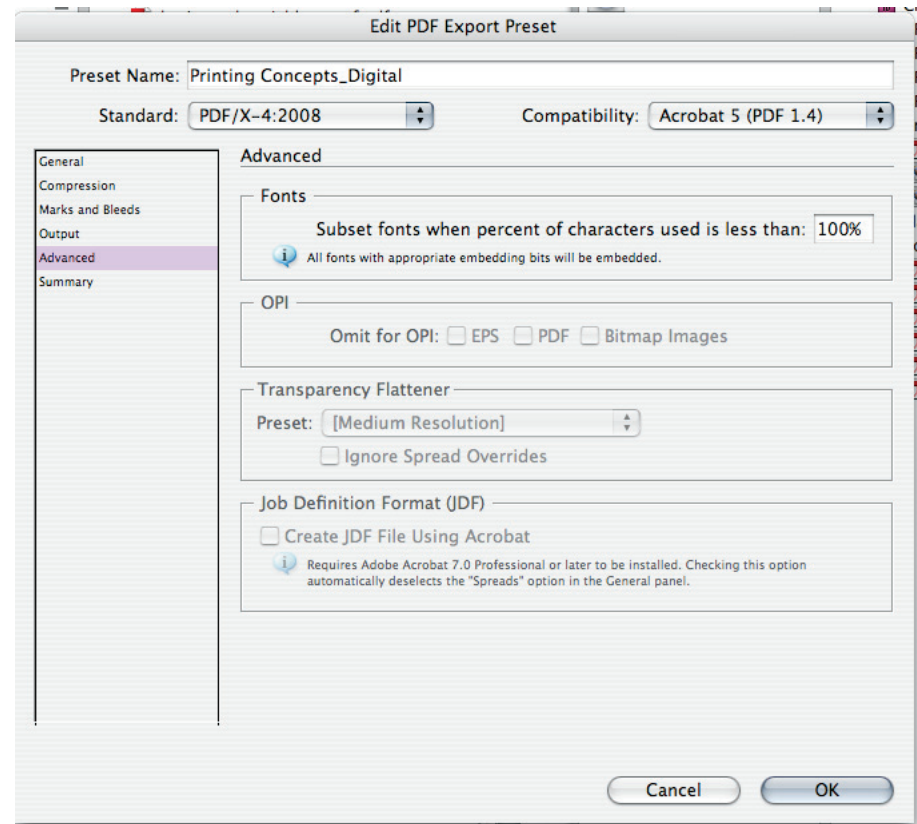
